IM|Sciences Scholarships / Grants / Financial Aid Undergraduate Level Session (2012-2016)

IM|Sciences is rigorously working alongside international development organizations, corporate sector and donor agencies to provide higher education opportunities to local and marginalized communities in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa including FATA and the country at large by a well developed Resource Generation Mechanism. The aim of strengthening the Institute in resource generation mechanism is to facilitate and meet the increased expectations of financially constrained but talented current and prospective students of the Institute through our robust outreach and communication strategies.

IM|Sciences has funded a significant number of students who had financial constraints and were unable to continue their education. In session 2011-2012, under 46 financial aid / scholarship programs, a total of 1288 students, which is 44 % of the total strength has been provided financial support worth Rs. 176.891/- Million, in the form of need-and-merit based scholarships, interest free student loans, siblings-fee-rebate, work study and global cultural exchange programs.

The following financial aid / scholarship programs are available at IM|Sciences for the financially needy and talented students.



HEC Fully Funded Need Based Merit Scholarships for BBA (Hons) / BCS (Hons) / BSc (Economics) and BSc (Social Sciences)

Higher Education Commission of Pakistan has initiated a Fully Funded Need Based Merit Scholarship Program for Pakistani Universities Students, which aims at providing equal opportunities to financially needy and talented students from marginalized, conflicted and far-off districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province, FATA, Gilgit & Baltistan, Malakand Division specifically and Pakistan in general. Female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply because, 25 % seats are reserved for female students for increased gender ratio in higher education. The scholarship award covers full tuition fee support and monthly financial assistance (accommodation, books, travelling and incidentals) of the said scholarship holders for their entire duration of stay in IM|Sciences. In Session 2011-2015, a total of 57 students have been approved for fully funded scholarships amounting Rs. 32.14 million.

For Session 2012-2016, these scholarships are available in the disciplines of BBA (Hons) / BCS (Hons) / BSc (Economics) and BSc (Social Sciences). The scholarship application form for this program has been provided with admission prospectus. The final list of selected scholarship holders will be announced before the last date of submission of admission fee. All the applicants have to submit their scholarship application forms with admission forms. Incomplete and late application forms will not be entertained.

IM|Sciences Fully Funded FATA Scholarship Program for BBA (Hons) / BCS (Hons) / BSc (Economics) and BSc (Social Sciences)

Based on the development need of FATA region, IM|Sciences has recently achieved another milestone in the shape of "IM|Sciences FATA Scholarship Program" with the cooperation of FATA Secretariat Peshawar. This new valuable scholarship program is funded by FATA Secretariat Peshawar for the duration of next 20 years. This program focuses on equal access of FATA students to graduate and post graduate degree courses in IM|Sciences.

These scholarships are available in the discipline of BBA (Hons) / BCS (Hons) / BSc (Economics) and BSc (Social Sciences). The award covers full tuition fee support and monthly stipend for transportation, accommodation, books and incidental charges for the 4 years study program in IM|Sciences. Female applicants are strongly encouraged to apply because, 30 % seats are reserved for female students for increased gender ratio in higher education.

Only FATA domiciled students can apply for this scholarship program. Priority will be given to those candidates who have completed their SSC examination from institutions located inside FATA. The scholarship application form for this program has been provided with admission prospectus. The final list of selected scholarship holders will be announced before the last date of submission of admission fee. All the applicants have to submit their scholarship application forms with admission forms. Incomplete and late application forms will not be entertained.



HEC French Need Based Merit Scholarship Program for BBA (Hons)

His Excellency Mr. Philippe THIEBAUD, Honorable Ambassador of France to Pakistan approved this distinctive fully funded French Govt Sponsored need based scholarships to financially needy but talented students of Institute of Management Sciences Peshawar. Under the supervision of Higher Education Commission of Pakistan, these scholarships will be awarded among deserving applicants from BBA (Hons) Session 2012-2016.

These scholarships include full tuition fee support, accommodation, books, travelling and incidental charges for the whole four (4) years duration in IMSciences Peshawar. The program focuses on financially needy but talented students from all over Pakistan. At least 25 % seats are reserved for female students for increased gender ratio in higher education.

The scholarship application form for this program has been provided with admission prospectus. The final list of selected scholarship holders will be announced before the last date of submission of admission fee. All the applicants have to submit their scholarship application forms with admission forms. Incomplete and late application forms will not be entertained.



IMSciences “Provision of Higher Education Opportunities for Students of FATA and Balochistan (President Directive) Scholarship Program”

IMSciences “Provision of Higher Education Opportunities for Students of FATA and Balochistan (President Directive) Scholarship Program” is aimed to match the twin criteria of merit and need, by providing fully funded scholarships to students of FATA and Balochistan who are unable to enter higher education due to financial constraints. This scholarship program is targeted towards 2000 Bachelors and Masters Level students belonging to FATA and Balochistan. All eligible students will have to apply through Higher Education Commission prescribed procedure. IM|Sciences Merit Based Partial Scholarships

BBA (Hons) / BBS (2 Years) / BCS / MBA (3 Semesters) and MPA

IM|Sciences Partial Scholarships are merit based and awarded to undergraduate and graduate level students depending on IM|Sciences admission test final weightage. A total of two hundred and fifty (250) students were awarded partial scholarships in session 2011. This scholarship program is available for BBA (Hons) / BBS (2 Years) / BCS / MBA (3 Semesters) and MPA disciplines. At the undergraduate level seventy (70) percent and at graduate level sixty five (65) percent fee relaxation is provided to scholars. Scholars are tenable to hold their scholarships for the whole duration of the program.

IM|Sciences Academic Talent Gender Based Merit Scholarships for B. Sc (Economics)

IM|Sciences Academic Talent Gender-Based Merit Scholarships are merit - based and awarded to B.Sc (Economics) students depending on IM|Sciences admission test final weightage. The program is renewable for 100 % tuition fee award in all eight semesters. The successful candidates are expected to be in top 10 positions in this program with minimum 3.00 CGPA at the end of each semester. These awards will be distributed on gender-equality basis, i.e. 5 male and 5 female students.

IMSciences Trust Semester Wise Merit Scholarships

These scholarships are purely based on merit and are granted to the most intelligent students of IM|Sciences who demonstrate their intellectual capabilities and achieve the maximum GPA in each Semester. These scholarships are granted in all eight semesters in Under-Graduate and four semesters in Graduate level programs respectively. In session 2011 total 153 IM|Sciences Trust scholarships were awarded to students from all disciplines.

Dr. Hidayatullah Need Based Merit Scholarships

This scholarship program is established and funded by the faculty and staff members of IM|Sciences for the benefit of those financially needy students who face financial hindrances in the middle or final stages of their study program. Under this financial aid program, IM|Sciences has successfully facilitated twenty three (23) such students from different disciplines and backgrounds for the completion of their higher education studies in IM|Sciences.

IM|Sciences Brother Sister Fee Rebate

These scholarships are available to all those students of the undergraduate and graduate level programs who are siblings. Under this scheme, 50 % tuition fee support is provided by the Institute. In session 2011, 129 students were awarded with this scholarship.



Workers Welfare Board Directorate of Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Scholarship Program

This program is administered by Workers Welfare Board, Directorate of Education Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for the benefit of those students whose parents are registered labor employees in industrial sector of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province. The scholarship covers full tuition fee support and other charges including transport, accommodation, library and computer lab charges. In session 2011, a total of 5 students were awarded this fully funded scholarship for successful completion of their studies.



USEF-Pakistan Cultural Exchange Programs to USA

The United States Education Foundation of Pakistan has top priority for students from marginalized communities of Pakistan to provide them international exposure in top world ranking universities of USA for 1 month, 1 semester and 1 year, non degree study in USA under USEFP Undergraduate Cultural Exchange Programs. In session 2011 total 21 students were selected in two consecutive batches to study in USA. Mahvash and Jahangir Siddiqui Foundation and Sajjad Foundation (Singapore) sponsored Summer Program on Economic and Enterprise Development in National University of Singapore (NUS)

The Mahvash and Jahangir Siddiqui Foundation is a non-profit organization that has been working towards healthcare, education and social enterprise through sustainable development to underprivileged members of society with a special focus on women, minorities, children and disabled individuals. Under this student exchange programme, the Mahvash and Jahangir Siddiqui Foundation sponsored (18) eighteen students after extensive interview sessions from 58 universities nationwide.

This is a two weeks summer program being held at the National University of Singapore (NUS). This program hosts undergraduate students from universities in various parts of the world and is an excellent opportunity for participants to learn about Singapore. These students will also get an opportunity to learn about creative and innovative ideas to start their own business in future.



Aga Khan Education Services
(Pakistan)

Aga Khan Education Service Pakistan (AKESP) Scholarships for Students of Chitral

These scholarships are provided by Aga Khan Education Service, Pakistan for students from Chitral. These scholarships are comprised of 50 % scholarship and 50 % student loan with flexible pay-back duration.



Fauji Foundation Excellence Award for Higher Professional Courses

These scholarships are awarded by Fauji Foundation for wards of Army Retired personnel. These awards are on annual basis and are renewable. The average amount of this scholarship is Rs. 12,000/- per annum and also depends on parents ranking in Pak Army.



P.A.F Shaheen Fellowships

These scholarships are awarded by Pakistan Air Force, Shaheen Foundation to the children of commissioned employees in PAF. These scholarships are awarded at both undergraduate and graduate levels. The average amount of this scholarship is Rs. 12,000/- per annum and also depends on parents ranking in PAF.



FFC (Fauji Fertilizer Company Limited) Ward of Farmers Scholarships

These scholarships are awarded by Fauji Fertilizers Company Ltd., for wards of farmers. The award is disbursed on semester basis. The amount of this scholarship is Rs. 9,000/- per annum.



UNESCO Scholarship Program

These scholarships are awarded by UNESCO (United Nations) to the dependants of its employees. These scholarships are awarded in both undergraduate and graduate levels. The average amount of this scholarship is 100 % tuition fee per annum and also depends on parents / Guardian ranking in UNESCO.



IM|Sciences Human Resource Development Center (HRDC) Need Based Scholarships

These scholarships are awarded by Human Resource Development Center (HRDC) to both undergraduate and graduate level needy students by providing 75 % tuition fee for one semester only. This award has special focus on students who study Human Resource Management as specialization in their study program. The awardees of this scholarship will have the opportunity to gain professional experience by working for HRDC for duration of 200 hours per annum.



Ihsan Trust Student Loan Scheme

The Meezan Islamic Bank Limited, Ihsan Trust extended its cooperation from Karachi and provided interest free student loans to 28 undergraduate level students of IM|Sciences Peshawar. The purpose of this financial aid was to realize the importance of public private partnership. This best example of corporate social responsibility resulted in noticeable social mobility of youngsters who belong to marginalized communities of Pakistan. This loan amount is provided for current and all the remaining semesters. This loan is interest free and repayable on monthly basis in manageable equal installments.



National Bank of Pakistan Student Loan Scheme

Pursuant to the announcement made by the Federal Finance Minister in his 2001-2002 budget speech, a Student Loan Scheme (SLS) for education was launched by the Government of Pakistan in collaboration with major commercial banks of Pakistan (NBP, HBL, UBL, MCB and ABL). Under the scheme, financial assistance is provided by way of interest free loans to the meritorious students who have financial constraints for pursuing their studies in various educational institutions within Pakistan. The scheme is being administered by a high powered committee comprising Deputy Governor, State Bank of Pakistan, Presidents of the commercial banks and representative of Ministry of Finance, Government of Pakistan.

20 % students out of the total applicants for this loan program are selected each year by the National Bank of Pakistan, for an amount of Rs. 60,000/- per annum. This loan amount is provided for 2 years at the graduate level and for 4 years at the undergraduate level. This loan is interest free and payable in 10 years duration after graduation.
